# PR19. REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

Members' attention was drawn to a schedule of maintenance work carried out on the Council's facilities since their previous meeting and that planned in the future. Particular mention was made of the work to upgrade the fire alarm system at the Amenity Centre and Workshop and improvements to the appearance of the Owen Pooley Hall and corridors which had been the subject of a deep clean and repaint. In response to which, Members placed on record their appreciation of the efforts of the Ground team and Clerk in undertaking the work.

With regard to planned maintenance, attention was drawn to an issue with a chimney at 50 Main Street which required further investigation as water was dripping down the stack causing damp to the bricked-up area. Whereupon, it was proposed by Councillor P Russell that a roofer or builder be asked to inspect and if possible make the necessary repairs to the chimney. This was seconded by Councillor J Lusted and **RESOLVED.** 

#### PR20. PORTACABIN

Members received an update on proposals to purchase a second hard portable mess room. It was reported that quotes received so far had come in over the budget of £5,000, although a possible 32 by 9 foot cabin was being advertised on the web for £4,500.
