19/01157/FUL	Proposed erection of security fence and gates – Peregrine Court, Falcon Way, Eagle Business Park, Yaxley	Recommended approval
19/01186/FUL	Proposed erection of a detached bungalow with garages – land south of the lodge Askews Lane, Yaxley.	Recommend approval
19/01141/FUL	Installation of Ventilation extract system, outside seating area and advertisement hoarding – 11A Broadway Shopping Centre, Malting Square, Yaxley.	Recommended approval with the caveat that the seating is limited to the confined outside area of the property.
19/01314/FUL	Erection of 7No Units for B1 & B2 Use including, layout of site, vehicle parking, appearance, access, landscaping and security fencing/gate access - Plot L Phase 2 Eagle Business Park Broadway	Recommend approval
